Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one National Network train through Nebraska, the *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Omaha-Lincoln-Denver-Salt Lake City-San Francisco Bay Area).

During FY15 Amtrak served the following Nebraska locations:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$3,505,537 on goods and services in Nebraska in FY15, most of it in Omaha, \$3,342,492.

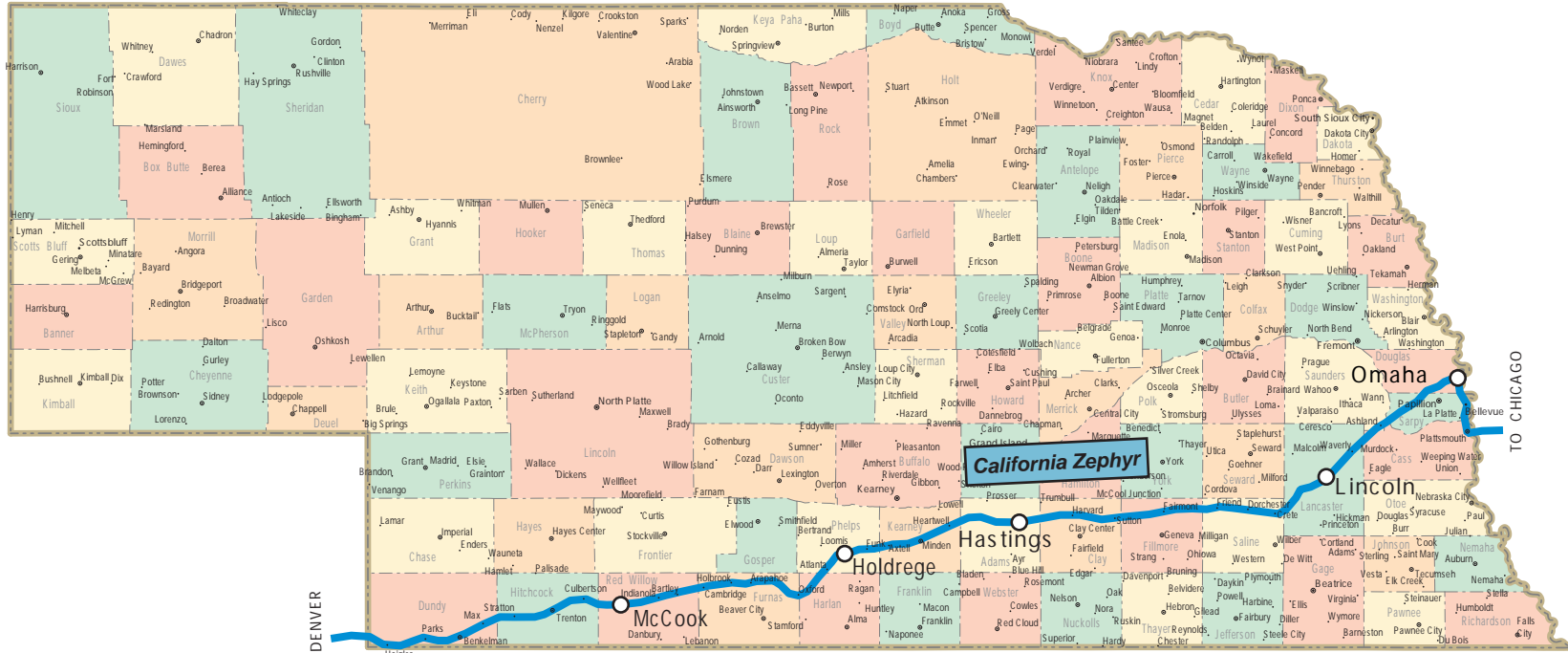
Employment

At the end of FY15, Amtrak employed 19 Nebraska residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Nebraska were \$1,891,461 during FY15.

Station Improvements

Improving ADA Accessibility: Amtrak will undertake work at and around stations as part of Amtrak's nationwide Americans with Disabilities Act compliance plan. In FY16, Amtrak will begin the design phase for these improvements at and around the Hastings and McCook stations.
