Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates two long-distance trains through Iowa:

- The *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Burlington-Denver-Salt Lake City-Emeryville/Bay Area)
- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Fort Madison-Kansas City-Los Angeles)

During FY04 Amtrak served the following Iowa locations:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak expended \$180,321 for goods and services in Iowa in FY04. Much of this money was spent in New Albin, \$80,191.
