### Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one long-distance train through Nebraska, the *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Omaha-Lincoln-Denver-Salt Lake City-San Francisco Bay Area).

During FY13 Amtrak served the following Nebraska locations:

### Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$5,039,106 on goods and services in Nebraska in FY13, most of it in Omaha, \$4,946,187.


### Employment

At the end of FY13, Amtrak employed 21 Nebraska residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Nebraska were \$1,979,263 during FY13.

### Station Development

- **Lincoln:** As part of the City's "Vision 2015 Plan", the BNSF mainline and Amtrak passenger station were relocated to allow construction of a new basketball arena for the University of Nebraska Cornhuskers. The new, fully ADA-compliant, 3,000-square-foot station opened June 25, 2012, at 510 N Street, a few blocks west of the former location. The \$1.3 million project included a new platform and 800-foot canopy.
