### Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one National Network train through Nebraska, the *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Omaha-Lincoln-Denver-Salt Lake City-San Francisco Bay Area).

During FY16 Amtrak served the following Nebraska locations:

### Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$3,441,686 on goods and services in Nebraska in FY16, much of it in Omaha, \$1,602,073.

### Employment


At the end of FY16, Amtrak employed 23 Nebraska residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Nebraska were \$2,139,747 during FY16.

In FY16, Amtrak moved the crew-change point for conductors and assistant conductors from Omaha to Lincoln. This was done to maximize efficiency and reduce costs for the *California Zephyr*. The crew-change point for locomotive engineers already was Lincoln.

### Station Improvements

**Improving ADA Accessibility:** Amtrak will undertake construction work in FY17 at Hastings and McCook, as part of Amtrak's nationwide Americans with Disabilities Act compliance plan.
