Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak serves North Dakota with one National Network train, the *Empire Builder* (Chicago-St. Paul-Seattle/Portland service via Fargo, Grand Forks, Devils Lake, Rugby, Minot, Stanley and Williston).

During FY16 Amtrak served the following North Dakota locations:

Amtrak spent \$2,934,571 on goods and services in North Dakota in FY16. Most of this was in the following locations:



Employment

At the end of FY16, Amtrak employed 10 North Dakota residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in North Dakota were \$770,069 during FY16.

Station Improvements

Improving ADA Accessibility: Amtrak is undertaking work at and around stations as part of a nationwide effort to gain compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. Amtrak has completed projects to improve path of travel from the public right-of-way to the train platform, restrooms, and signage at Devils Lake, Fargo, Rugby, Stanley, and Williston.
