Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one National Network train through Nebraska, the *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Omaha-Lincoln-Denver-Salt Lake City-San Francisco Bay Area).

During FY17 Amtrak served the following Nebraska locations:

Amtrak spent \$3,697,054 on goods and services in Nebraska in FY17, including at:

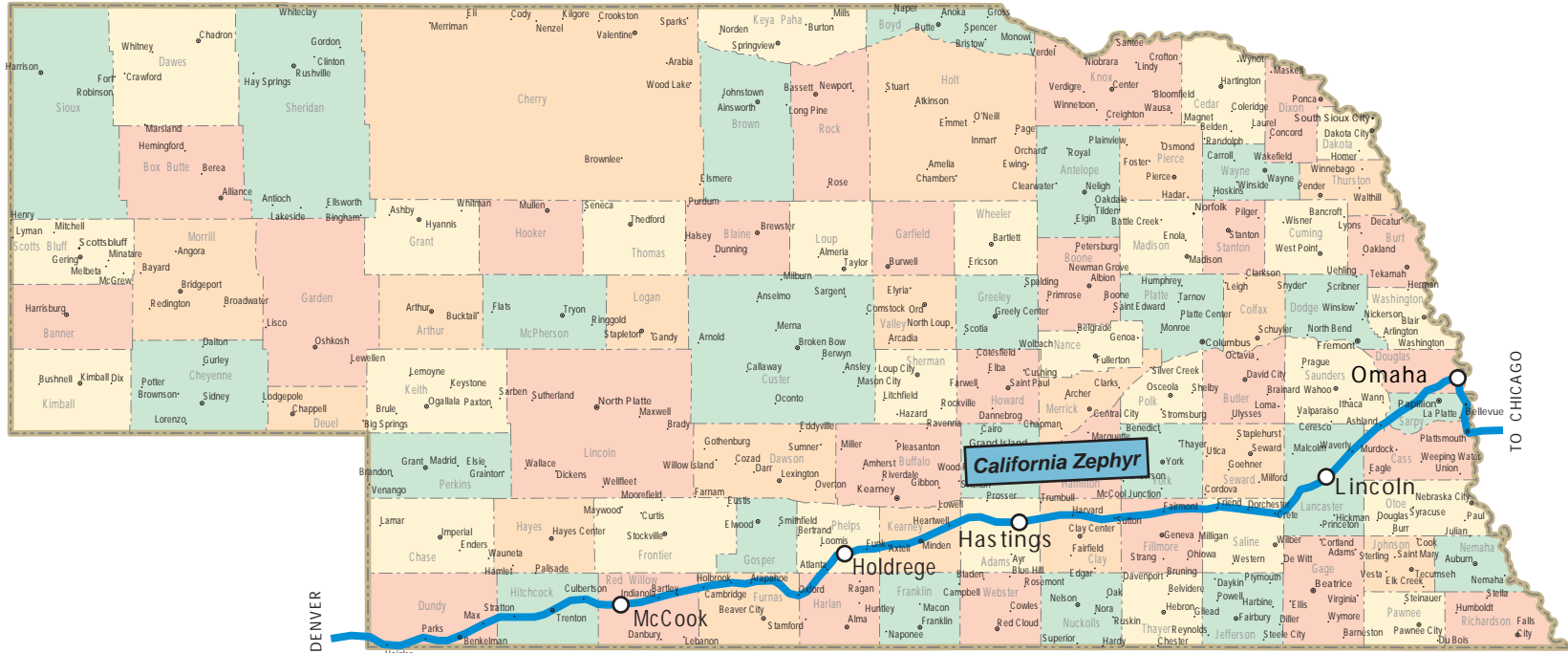

Employment

At the end of FY17, Amtrak employed 24 Nebraska residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Nebraska were \$1,970,071 during FY17.

Lincoln Crew Base: In FY16 and FY17, Amtrak consolidated a single crew base in Lincoln that serves both the eastbound and westbound *California Zephyr* trains. Crew bases in Omaha and Denver were consolidated into one base in the Lincoln station. This was done to maximize efficiency and reduce costs for the *California Zephyr*.
